<u>Staff Report – Rebecca Wold:</u> Wold introduced herself and gave an update on the Public Health Emergency Preparedness (PHEP) program.

Wold indicated one goal of the program is implementing a crisis emergency response team (CERT). One staff member and potentially another partner would be trained to become a CERT trainer. The goal for Oneida County is to have volunteers in the community to get basic training on how to respond to hazards in the county and form a CERT. Educational materials such as mini flashlights and magnets with the CDC infographic for food safety without power would be provided to each participant.

OCHD is looking to purchase a mobile unit to do mobile offsite vaccination clinics, mobile WIC and Reproductive Health clinics, etc with the goal to bring services to underserved areas in the county.
