

Oneida County Board of Canvas February 20, 2020

Spring Primary Election

Proceedings of the Oneida County Board of Canvass was held in the County Clerk's Office, Election Conference Room, Oneida County Courthouse, First Floor, on Thursday, February 20, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. The purpose was to canvass the Spring Primary held February 18, 2020.

Meeting Notice was posted February 19, 2020, at 8:55 a.m. on the Courthouse Bulletin Board by Tracy Hartman, County Clerk per Wis Stats. Media notified February 19, 2020 at 8:55 a.m., via mail/fax/email.

Present: Heidi Nehls, Chief Deputy Clerk; Cindy Skinner, Town of Pine Lake Clerk; and Carla Fletcher, Town of Crescent Chief Election Inspector.

Meeting/Canvass was called to order by Cindy Skinner at 9:00 a.m. Poll lists with supplemental lists, absentee ballot logs, tally sheets, tapes, and Inspector's Statements will be reviewed. Voter/ballot numbers to be checked for accuracy and compared to election night report. Forms to be checked for signatures and correct completion. Notations will be made below and municipal clerks will be contacted. The Tabular Statement of Votes Cast will be filled in after each municipality is reviewed. Upon completion of the reviews, the election night results will be reconciled for any errors and the Summary Statement of the Board of Canvassers along with the Certification will be completed and signed by the board and will be made a part of these minutes. Entries will be made into WisVote and the printed Summary Statement and Certification will be signed and mailed to the Wisconsin Elections Commission. Provisional Ballots for Pine Lake was outstanding at the start of Board of Canvass, the voter requested to withdraw her Provisional Ballot.

Absentee number incorrect on the Inspectors Statement. Voter Statistic section incorrect. Last voter number not circled. Serial number from bag not recorded.

No Tally Sheet for scattering. No name listed for Write-In.

Town of Enterprise – Voters – 119/ Ballots Cast – 119

No Absentee Voter Log. Missing EDR number. No Tally Sheet for Write-In. Registrations not completed correctly.

Town of Hazelhurst – Voters – 476/ Ballots Cast – 476

Last voter number was circled, but not in red. Incorrect Voter Statistic portion of Inspectors Statement incorrect. Serial number from bag not recorded.

Town of Lake Tomahawk (Wards 1 and 2) – Voters – 347/ Ballots Cast – 347
Last voter number not circled. Inspectors Statement not initialed by Chief Inspector. Serial number for bag not recorded.

Town of Little Rice – Voters – 111/ Ballots Cast – 111
All reports signed and completed correctly.

Town of Lynne – Voters – 34/ Ballots Cast – 34
Last voter number not circled in Poll Book.

Town of Minocqua – Voters – 1513/ Ballots Cast – 1513
Last voter number not circled. No Tally Sheet for Write-ins. Absentee Ballot Log not completed.

Town of Monico – Voters – 65/ Ballots Cast – 65
Last voter number not circled.

Town of Newbold (Ward 1) – Voters – 97/ Ballots Cast – 98 (ballot stuck together, unvoted)
All reports signed and completed correctly.

Town of Newbold (Wards 2, 3 and 4) – Voters – 671/ Ballots Cast – 671
All reports signed and completed correctly.

Town of Nokomis – Voters – 362/ Ballots Cast – 362
Call-In sheet was not accurate. The Poll Book was written in red ink.

Absentee Log isn't numbered with voter numbers. No Tally Sheet for Write-Ins. Supplemental list not updated. Destroyed and remade ballots should be in separate envelopes and put in ballot bag.

Town of Piehl – Voters – 14/ Ballots Cast – 14
Certification Page complete, but wrong page number was listed for last voter number.

Town of Pine Lake – Voters – 624/ Ballots Cast – 624
All reports signed and completed correctly.

Town of Schoepke – Voters – 113/ Ballots Cast – 113
Voter Statistic portion of Inspectors Statement not correct. Last voter number not circled. Serial number from bag not recorded.

Town of Stella – Voters – 144/ Ballots Cast – 144
Total paper ballots not listed on Tally Sheets. Write-In not noted on Tally Sheet.

Town of Sugar Camp – Voters – 527/ Ballots Cast – 526
Ballot incident, ballot should have been overridden.

Town of Three Lakes – Voters – 698/ Ballots Cast – 698
Per Inspectors Statement, two numbers were stuck together.

Town of Woodboro – Voters – 236/ Ballots Cast – 235
Absentees missing on Certification Page. DRE number missing from Inspectors Statement.

Town of Woodruff – Voters – 637/ Ballots Cast – 637
No Tally Sheet for Write-Ins.

City of Rhinelander – Ward 1 – Voters – 155/ Ballots Cast – 155
No notations on EL-104 for rejected Absentee Ballots.

City of Rhinelander – (Wards 2 and 3) – Voters – 129/ Ballots Cast – 129
No Tally Sheet for hand counted ballot. No notations on EL-104 for rejected Absentee Ballots.

City of Rhinelander – (Wards 4 and 5) – Voters – 133/ Ballots Cast – 133
No Tally Sheet for Write-In and paper Ballots. No Chief Inspector signature or initials. No notations on EL-104 for rejected Absentee Ballots.

City of Rhinelander – (Wards 6 and 7) – Voters – 113/ Ballots Cast – 113
No notations on EL-104 for rejected Absentee Ballots.

City of Rhinelander – (Wards 8 and 9) – Voters – 253/ Ballots Cast – 253
Voter Statistic portion of Inspectors Statement not correct. No Tally sheets for Write-Ins. No notation on Inspectors Statement as to rejected Absentee Ballots. Absentee number missed in Poll Book.

City of Rhinelander – Ward 10 – Voters – 149/ Ballots Cast – 149
Last voter number not circled. No Tally Sheet for hand counted paper ballots. No notations for rejected Absentee Ballots on EL-104.

City of Rhinelander – (Wards 11 and 12) – Voters – 150/ Ballots Cast – 150
Serial number from bag not listed. Chief inspector did not sign Inspectors Statement. No notations for rejected ballots on EL-104.

City of Rhinelander – (Wards 13 and 14) – Voters – 126/ Ballots Cast – 126
No notations on EL-104 for rejected Absentee Ballots.

Reconciliation completed, information was recorded in WisVote. The Certification was signed. Oneida County Board of Canvassers was adjourned at 3:50 p.m.
