Proceedings of the Oneida County Board of Canvass held in the County Clerk's Office, Oneida County Courthouse, First Floor, on Friday, February 21, 2025 at 9:00 a.m. The purpose is to canvass the Spring Primary held February 18, 2025.

Meeting notices were posted and media was notified by Tracy Hartman, County Clerk per Wis Stats.

Meeting/Canvass was called to order on Friday, February 21, 2025 by Tracy Hartman at 9:00 a.m.

Present: Tracy Hartman, County Clerk; Cindy Skinner, Town of Pine Lake Clerk; Heidi Nehls, Chief Deputy Clerk; Carla Fletcher, Town of Crescent Chief Election Inspector.
