Proceedings of the Oneida County Board of Canvass held in the County Clerk's Office, Oneida County Courthouse, First Floor, on Thursday, August 13, 2026 and Monday, August 17, 2026. The purpose is to canvass the Partisan Primary held August 11, 2026.

Meeting notices were posted and media was notified by Tracy Hartman, County Clerk per Wis Stats.

Meeting/Canvass was called to order on Thursday, August 13, 2026 by Tracy Hartman at 9:00 a.m.

Present: Tracy Hartman, County Clerk; Cindy Skinner, Town of Pine Lake Clerk; Heidi Nehls, Chief Deputy Clerk; Carla Fletcher, Town of Crescent Chief Election Inspector.

Poll lists with supplemental lists, absentee ballot logs, tally sheets, tapes, and Inspector's Statements will be reviewed. Voter/ballot numbers to be checked for accuracy and compared to election night report. Forms to be checked for signatures and correct completion. Notations will be made below and municipal clerks will be contacted. The Tabular Statement of Votes Cast will be filled in after each municipality is reviewed. Upon completion of the reviews, the election night results will be reconciled for any errors and the Summary Statement of the Board of Canvassers along with the Certification will be completed and signed by the board and will be made a part of these minutes. Entries will be made into WisVote and the printed Summary Statement and Certification will be signed and mailed to the Wisconsin Elections Commission.
