• Fall Election •
November 8, 2022

Proceedings of the Oneida County Board of Canvass held in the County Clerk's Office, Oneida County Courthouse, First Floor, on Friday, November 11, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. and Monday, November 14, 2022 at 12:30 p.m. The purpose is to canvass the Fall Election held November 8, 2022.

Meeting notices were posted and media was notified November 10, 2022 and November 12, 2022 by Tracy Hartman, County Clerk per Wis Stats.

Meeting/Canvass was called to order on Friday, November 11, 2022 by Cindy Skinner at 9:00 a.m.

Poll lists with supplemental lists, absentee ballot logs, tally sheets, tapes, and Inspector's Statements will be reviewed. Voter/ballot numbers to be checked for accuracy and compared to election night report. Forms to be checked for signatures and correct completion. Notations will be made below and municipal clerks will be contacted. The Tabular Statement of Votes Cast will be filled in after each municipality is reviewed. Upon completion of the reviews, the election night results will be reconciled for any errors and the Summary Statement of the Board of Canvassers along with the Certification will be completed and signed by the board and will be made a part of these minutes. Entries will be made into WisVote and the printed Summary Statement and Certification will be signed and mailed to the Wisconsin Elections Commission.

Town of Cassian (Wards 1 & 2) – Voters – 695/ Ballots Cast – 694

Last voter number not circled. Voters exceed number of ballots. Election Day Registration numbers were listed incorrect, voters were registered and signed in Poll Book. Voter numbers not issued to some voters. Some voters did not sign the poll book. Absentees not written in red. EDR's not complete, information was missing on forms. Serial number from bag not recorded.

Town of Crescent (Wards 1-3) – Voters – 1189/ Ballots Cast – 1189

All reports signed and completed correctly.

Town of Enterprise – Voters – 222/ Ballots Cast – 222

Inspector's Statement not complete, pre-election initial missing.

Town of Hazelhurst – Voters – 817/ Ballots Cast – 817

Absentee numbers not correct, 176 listed on Inspector's Statement and 177 actual. Optical Scan number not listed on Inspector's Statement. Serial number from bag not recorded. Incident log did not list incidents.

Town of Lake Tomahawk (Ward 1 & 2) – Voters – 655/ Ballots Cast – 655

No tally sheet for paper ballots, CBOC created one.

Town of Little Rice – Voters – 212/ Ballots Cast – 212

All reports signed and completed correctly.

Town of Lynne – Voters – 86/ Ballots Cast – 85

One more voter than ballot. Tape from machine not signed.

Town of Minocqua (Wards 1 - 7) – Voters – 3064/ Ballots Cast – 3063

Voters exceed number of ballots, voter did not insert ballot per report. No Tally Sheet for registered write-in.

Town of Monico – Voters – 156/ Ballots Cast – 156

Last voter number not circled.

Town of Newbold (Ward 1) – Voters – 213/ Ballots Cast – 213

Last voter number not circled on page 44. Tally Sheet not correct.

Town of Newbold (Ward 2 - 4) – Voters – 1462/ Ballots Cast – 1462

Voter Statistic Section of Inspector's Statement not correct, EDR number inaccurate.

Town of Nokomis – Voters – 869/ Ballots Cast – 869

Last voter number on page 102 not circled. Voter Statistic portion of Inspector's Statement not complete, missing optical scan total. Serial number from bag not recorded.

Town of Pelican (Wards 1 - 4) – Voters – 1468/ Ballots Cast – 1468

Voter Statistic section of Inspector's Statement not accurate, EDR total inaccurate.

Town of Piehl – Voters – 36/ Ballots Cast – 36

Certification Page not complete, inaccurate voter totals. Absentee totals missing. Inspectors Statement lists wrong total of voters. No tally sheet for paper ballot, CBOC created tally sheet. No Absentee Ballot Log.

Town of Pine Lake (Wards 1 - 4) – Voters – 1432/ Ballots Cast – 1432

All reports signed and completed correctly.

Town of Schoepke – Voters – 265/ Ballots Cast – 265

All reports signed and completed correctly.

Town of Stella (Ward 1 & 2) – Voters – 342/ Ballots Cast – 342

All reports signed and completed correctly.

Town of Sugar Camp – Voters – 1117/ Ballots Cast – 1117
EDR totals listed not correct.

Town of Three Lakes – Voters – 1500/ Ballots Cast – 1500
Last voter number on page 167 not circled.

Town of Woodboro – Voters – 507/ Ballots Cast – 507
Last voter number on page 507 not circled. Voter Statistic section of Inspector's Statement not complete; missing Optical Scan number and EDR total inaccurate. Inspector's Statement not initialed.

Town of Woodruff (Wards 1 - 3) – Voters – 1167/ Ballots Cast – 1167
Inspectors Statement not initialed by Chief Inspector and missing Serial Number from bag. Tally sheets list only scattering, names not listed.

City of Rhinelander – (Ward 1 – 3) – Voters – 315/ Ballots Cast – 315
Tally sheet totals not correct, CBOC updated.

City of Rhinelander – (Ward 4 & 5) – Voters – 349/ Ballots Cast – 349
Serial number from bag not recorded.

City of Rhinelander – (Ward 6 & 11) – Voters – 302/ Ballots Cast – 302
Optical Scan total missing on Inspector's Statement.

City of Rhinelander – (Ward 7 & 8) – Voters – 426/ Ballots Cast – 426
Incorrect number circled for last voter number, last voter number was incorrect. Optical Scan total missing on Inspectors Statement. Absentee total listed in error. Number of voters did not exceed number of ballots, duplicate number was issued. Serial number for bag not listed.

City of Rhinelander – (Wards 9 & 12) – Voters – 420/ Ballots Cast – 419
One more voter than ballot, it was determined to offset Wards 10 & 13 and wrong ballot was given. Inspector's Statement not correct; Voter totals listed with incorrect numbers and paper ballots were reported but there were no paper ballots. Voter totals reported in error to county on call in sheet, matched sheets to tally tape to determine. Tape did not match reported totals for Secretary of State Office. Inspector's Statement not initialed and serial number from bag not recorded.

City of Rhinelander – (Wards 10 & 13) – Voters – 355/ Ballots Cast – 356
Last voter number on page 63 not circled. One more ballot than voter, it was determined to offset Wards 9, 12 and the wrong ballot was issued. Inspector's Statement not initialed and missing serial number from bag.

City of Rhinelander – (Ward 14 & 16) – Voters – 384/ Ballots Cast – 384

Inspector's Statement not complete; optical scan portion not filled in, voter totals incorrect, ballots cast total incorrect and serial number from bag not listed.

City of Rhinelanders – (Wards 15 & 17) – Voters – 347/ Ballots Cast – 347
Optical Scan number not listed on Inspector's Statement.
