Proceedings of the Oneida County Board of Canvass held in the County Clerk's Office, Oneida County Courthouse, First Floor, on Friday, November 8 and 11, 2024. The purpose is to canvass the Partisan Primary held November 5, 2024.

Meeting notices were posted and media was notified by Tracy Hartman, County Clerk per Wis Stats.

Meeting/Canvass was called to order on Friday, November 8, 2024 by Cindy Skinner at 9:00 a.m.

Present: Tracy Hartman, County Clerk; Cindy Skinner, Town of Pine Lake Clerk; Heidi Nehls, Chief Deputy Clerk; Carla Fletcher, Town of Crescent Chief Election Inspector.

Poll lists with supplemental lists, absentee ballot logs, tally sheets, tapes, and Inspector's Statements will be reviewed. Voter/ballot numbers to be checked for accuracy and compared to election night report. Forms to be checked for signatures and correct completion. Notations will be made below and municipal clerks will be contacted. The Tabular Statement of Votes Cast will be filled in after each municipality is reviewed. Upon completion of the reviews, the election night results will be reconciled for any errors and the Summary Statement of the Board of Canvassers along with the Certification will be completed and signed by the board and will be made a part of these minutes. Entries will be made into WisVote and the printed Summary Statement and Certification will be signed and mailed to the Wisconsin Elections Commission.

Town of Cassian – Voters – 820/ Ballots Cast – 820

Absentee total was not listed on the Certification Page. Wrong last voter number listed. EDR total not listed on Inspectors Statement. Call-in sheet not signed. Voter voted without a registration. Overseas voter emailed ballot back with no certification received, this should have been rejected. Ballot should have been placed in ballot bag. Voter numbers were listed on remade ballots, this should not be listed. Tamper Evident seal not recorded. Serial number for bag not recorded.

All reports signed and completed correctly.

No tally sheet for registered write-ins.

Town of Hazelhurst – Voters – 954/ Ballots Cast – 954

Last voter number listed incorrectly.

Town of Lake Tomahawk – Voters – 785/ Ballots Cast – 785

No tally sheet for paper ballot. EDR number listed incorrect. Original Absentee ballots that were remade were not placed in the ballot bag.

Town of Little Rice – Voters – 273/ Ballots Cast – 273

All reports signed and completed correctly.

Town of Lynne – Voters – 116/ Ballots Cast – 116

All reports signed and completed correctly.

Town of Minocqua – Voters – 3653/ Ballots Cast – 3653

All reports signed and completed correctly.

Town of Monico – Voters – 192/ Ballots Cast – 192

Signed call-in sheet not received.

Town of Newbold (Ward 1) – Voters – 296/ Ballots Cast – 296

All reports signed and completed correctly.

Town of Newbold (Ward 2, 3, 4) – Voters – 1732/ Ballots Cast – 1732

Last voter number is in error listed as 1731 when total number of voters were 1732. Looks to be an error in the numbering system.

Town of Nokomis – Voters – 1065/ Ballots Cast – 1065

Last voter number not circled. Signed call-in sheet not submitted. EDR total not listed correctly. Memory device number not listed.

Town of Pelican – Voters – 1780/ Ballots Cast – 1780

All reports signed and completed correctly.

Town of Piehl – Voters – 48/ Ballots Cast – 48

Voter Statistic section not correct.

Town of Pine Lake – Voters – 1758/ Ballots Cast – 1758

All reports signed and completed correctly.

Town of Schoepke – Voters – 306/ Ballots Cast – 306

EDR totals not listed correctly.

Town of Stella – Voters – 414/ Ballots Cast – 414

Absentee total not listed correct.

Town of Sugar Camp – Voters – 1324/ Ballots Cast – 1324

All reports signed and completed correctly.

Town of Three Lakes – Voters – 1848/ Ballots Cast – 1848

All reports signed and completed correctly.

Town of Woodboro – Voters – 607/ Ballots Cast – 607

EDR totals not correct.

Town of Woodruff – Voters – 1429/ Ballots Cast – 1429

Voter was given a ballot and not listed in the Pollbook, this was noted on Inspectors Statement.

City of Rhinelander – Voters – 3904/ Ballots Cast – 3899

5 more voters than ballots, Absentee envelopes counted. Could not determine. Note in Inspectors Statement noted that when voter signed the machine powered off and had to resign. Original remade ballots need to be placed in ballot bag.
