## Spring Primary

### February 16, 2021

Proceedings of the Oneida County Board of Canvass held in the County Clerk's Office, Oneida County Courthouse, First Floor, on Thursday, February 18, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. The purpose is to canvass the April Spring Primary held February 16, 2021.

Meeting Notice was posted February 17, 2021, at 8:00 a.m. on the Courthouse Bulletin Board by Tracy Hartman, County Clerk per Wis Stats. Media notified February 17, 2021 at 8:00 a.m., via mail/fax/email.

Meeting/Canvass was called to order on Thursday, February 18, 2021 by Tracy Hartman at 9:00 a.m.

Poll lists with supplemental lists, absentee ballot logs, tally sheets, tapes, and Inspector's Statements will be reviewed. Entries will be made into WisVote and the printed Summary Statement and Certification will be signed and mailed to the Wisconsin Elections Commission. No Provisional Ballots were issued.
