7. Credit Account Applications for Overhead Solutions

8. Bid Results and Bid Approval for Vehicle Weight Scale Project

Bauknecht reported that four bids were received for the vehicle weight scale project

Motion by Cushing, second by Kilbourn to approve the bid from Weigh-Rite Scale Company for \$115,485 for the vehicle weight scale project. All ayes. Motion carried.

9. 2026 and 2027 Capital Improvement Projects

Bauknecht reviewed the approved 2026 Capital Improvement Projects and suggested rolling the Hook Truck to 2027. The Solid Waste Committee discussed the proposed 2027 projects. Crack Sealing was removed and a new wheel loader was moved to 2027 instead of 2028. The remaining projects were approved and ranked in the following order. 1-used Hook Truck, 2- Blower/Flare, 3- Wheel Loader, 4- Pickup Truck with plow. Motion by Timmons, second by Cushing, to forward the projects to the Executive Committee. All ayes. Motion carried.

10. Compost Update

Bauknecht advised the Committee that after further reviewing the PFAS test results of both the composted and the raw fiber cake, she has inquired with the DNR about possibly land spreading the raw fiber cake. The DNR is holding internal meetings with the Waste Water Department and the Solid Waste Management Departments. Bauknecht is also working with Sand County Environmental on a couple different methods to try to further reduce the PFAS in the fiber cake and also dry it.
