MINUTES:

- 1. <u>Call to Order and President's Announcements</u>: President Fred Andrist called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. The meeting was properly posted. The facility is handicap accessible.
- 2. <u>Approve Agenda for Today's Meeting</u>: A motion was made by White/Sprecksel to approve the agenda. <u>Motion</u> <u>carried</u>.
- 3. <u>Review Emergency Procedures:</u> Ken Kortenhoff did not show; White and Salzman to report on Item #9-d.
- 4. <u>Date(s) of Future Meetings</u>: The next Fair meeting is August 13, 2019 at 6:00 pm at the Airport.
- 5. <u>Approve Minutes of June 4 and June 13, 2019</u>: A motion was made by Perlberg/White to approve the minutes of July 9, 2019. <u>Motion carried</u>.
- 6. <u>Treasurer's Report</u>: No report was given.
 - a. <u>Review Process for Purchasing Items for the Fair</u>: Bill Freudenberg reported there is \$500 petty cash and no credit card will be used for purchases. Use the appropriate form including our tax ID# and give to Bill.
- 7. <u>CUW Committee Rep Report</u>: No report as Winkler was excused from the meeting.
- 8. Fair Coordinator Report:
 - a. <u>Overall Status Update</u>: Barnett reported he is proud of the committee and the way the Fair is shaping up so far. Carnival wristbands are \$20 with no presales.
 - b. **Fish Fry**: Kulkanek is providing two deep fryers, we have the freezer and CT is providing the cooler.
- 9. Other Area Reports:
 - a. <u>**Trolley**</u>: The schedule is booked.
 - b. **<u>Raffle</u>**: Perlberg reported \$2,100.00 worth of tickets have been sold so far.
 - c. <u>Courtesy Carts</u>: There are some openings yet and committee members stepped up to volunteer.
 - d. <u>Medical Assistance</u>: Salzman reported Kortenhoff gave the Fair an AED to keep; there will be one in the office, one with Salzman, one with Fred. We have five 1st Aid Kits to be kept on the trolley and 4-H tent and on golf carts. Gloves and masks are available.

- e. **Volunteers**: Bonnie Breivogel will help with petty cash and volunteers; also as a resource in the office.
- f. <u>Others</u>: Warning to not use the radios excessively. Use of courtesy carts was discussed. Put up Farmer's Market signs. A motion was made by White/Salzman that no golf carts are to be used on city streets, just the sidewalks. <u>Motion carried</u>.
- **10.** <u>Old Business</u>: Lehner stressed the importance of using the proper receipt forms and to sign each one. Bill Freudenberg volunteered to do something to help with input, such as a type of survey.
