WHEREAS, the Town of Little Rice has filed a petition for emergency county aid for the cost of installing a culvert under Section 82.08 over Brown Creek on Brown Creek Road, and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the labor, materials, and equipment was \$17,815.00, of which the town received Wisconsin Department of Transportation Disaster Damage Aid in the amount of \$13,361.25, which leaves the total cost to the town at \$4,453.75 and the County share under Section 82.08 would be 50% of the \$4,453.75 or \$2,226.88.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that \$2,226.88 be paid to the Town of Little Rice, and the money to come from the Town Bridge Aid Account.

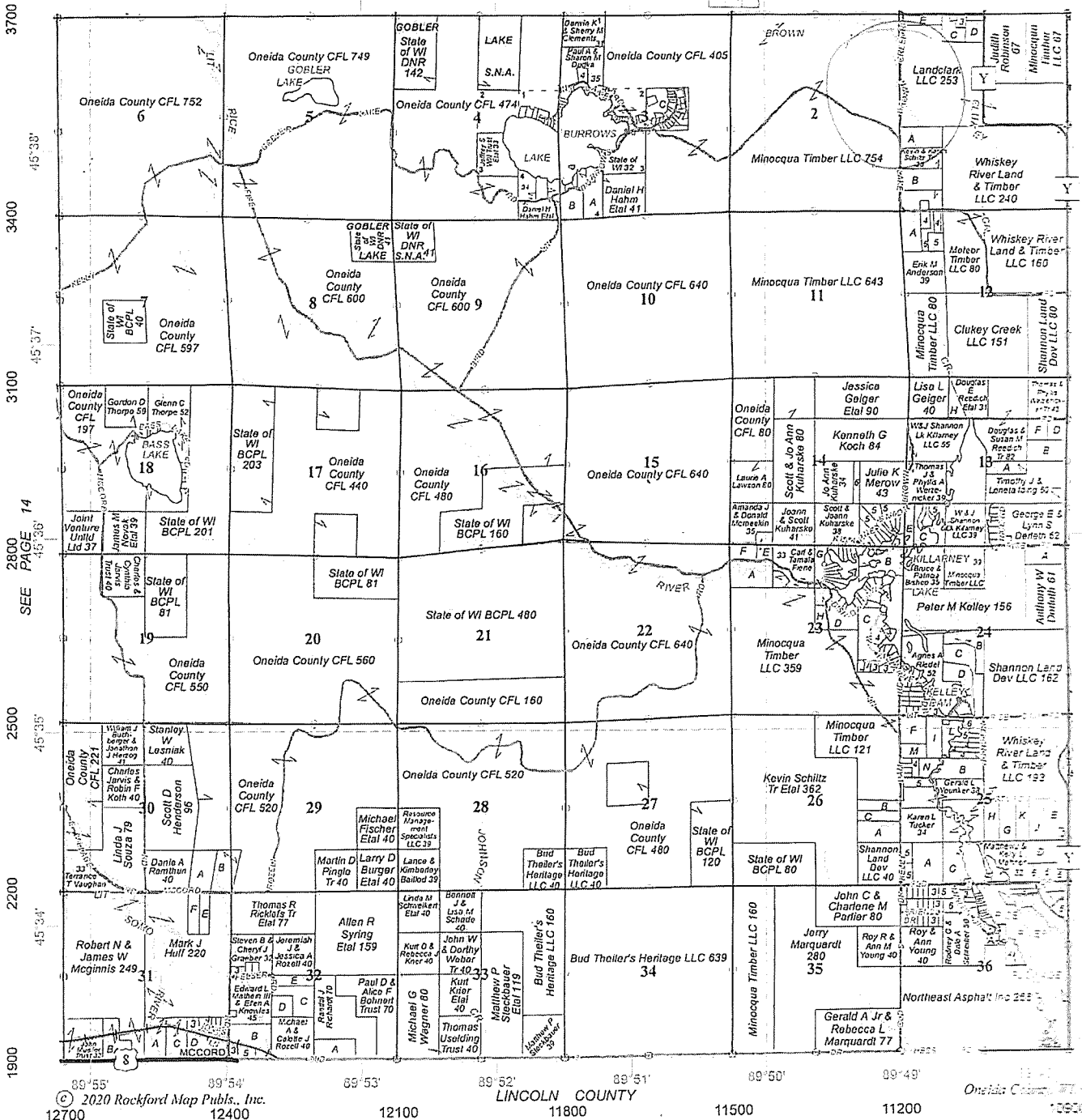




SOUTH PART **LITTLE RICE**



If we get the D.O.T to fund the project, Pitlick thought it would be around \$55,000 for the project. The D.O. T. will pay 75% of that for \$41,250, leaving \$13,750 left for the town and county to split for a total of \$6875 for the county and \$6875 for the town. If the D.O.T doesn't pay it would be around \$27,500 each for the town and County. Won't know anymore until our town board meeting on Thursday night. Naturally these are rough numbers that we came up with to submit the paperwork. If the town can just replace the existing culvert our way the numbers should be close. If the DNR gets it done their way, it sounds like we would be denied the D.O.T funding and the bill would be around \$135,000 for the town and county to split.
