Resolution to seek aid for the Rhinelander/Oneida County Airport

Resolution offered by the Administration Committee.

Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Oneida County, Wisconsin:

WHEREAS, the Rhinelander/Oneida County Airport Commission is in the process of petitioning the Secretary of Transportation for Airport Improvement Aid; and

WHEREAS, the Rhinelander/Oneida County Airport Commission has approved the attached resolution as part of their petition; and

WHEREAS, the usual funding for the Rhinelander/Oneida County Airport has been one million dollars for the Federal Aviation Administration approved projects; and

WHEREAS, all three funding sources come from aviation user fees, airline ticket tax, aircraft registration, Passenger Facility Charges, etc.; and

WHEREAS, the Rhinelander/Oneida County Airport has received over 50 million dollars in grants since 1948; and

WHEREAS, as a co-sponsor of the Rhinelander/Oneida County Airport, Oneida County must approve petitioning the Secretary of Transportation for Airport Improvement Aid,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Oneida County Board of Supervisors does hereby support the Rhinelander/Oneida County Airport in its petition for Airport Improvement Aid from the Secretary of Transportation; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Oneida County Board of Supervisors adopts the findings and conclusions in the attached resolution of the Rhinelander/Oneida County Airport Commission and directs the County Board Chairman and County Clerk to sign the necessary paperwork in order to receive the aforementioned aid.

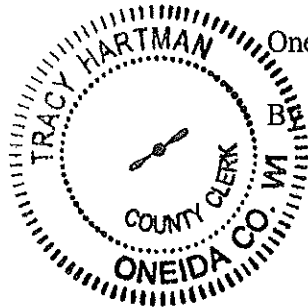

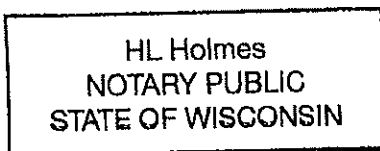

**RESOLUTION PETITIONING
THE SECRETARY OF TRANSPORTATION
FOR AIRPORT IMPROVEMENT AID

**Rhinelanders – Oneida County Airport
Oneida County, Wisconsin**

WHEREAS, the Rhinelanders - Oneida County Airport Commission, Oneida County, Wisconsin hereinafter referred to as the sponsor, being a municipal body corporate of the State of Wisconsin, is authorized by Wis. Stat. §114.11 (1973), to acquire, establish, construct, own, control, lease, equip, improve, maintain, and operate an airport, and

WHEREAS, the sponsor desires to develop or improve the Rhinelanders – Oneida County Airport, Oneida County, Wisconsin,

"PETITION FOR AIRPORT PROJECT"

WHEREAS, the foregoing proposal for airport improvements has been referred to the city plan commission for its consideration and report prior to council action as required by Wis. Stat. §62.23(5) (1973), and

WHEREAS, airport users have been consulted in formulation of the improvements included in this resolution, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held prior to the adoption of this petition in accordance with Wis. Stat. §114.33(2) (1973) as amended, and a transcript of the hearing is transmitted with this petition, and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the sponsor that a petition for federal and (or) state aid in the following form is hereby approved:

The petitioner, desiring to sponsor an airport development project with federal and state aid or state aid only, in accordance with the applicable state and federal laws, respectfully represents and states:

1. That the airport, which it is desired to develop, should generally conform to the requirements for a Primary Commercial Service type airport as defined by the Federal Aviation Administration.
2. The character, extent, and kind of improvements desired under the project are as follows: Rehabilitate and remodel terminal building; Reconstruct airfield lighting including guidance signs; Reconstruct/Replace NAVAIDs including PAPIs, REILs, Wind Cone and Rotating Beacon; Replace Electrical Vault Equipment; Airport Rescue and Firefighting (ARFF) building expansion; Acquire ARFF vehicle; Airfield pavement maintenance; Land acquisition in runway approaches; Acquire snow removal and mowing equipment; clear and maintain runway approaches as stated in Wis. Admin. Code Trans §55.06(3) (1997); and any necessary related work.
3. That the airport project, which your petitioner desires to sponsor, is necessary for the following reasons: to meet the existing and future needs of the airport.

WHEREAS, it is recognized that the improvements petitioned for as listed will be funded individually or collectively as funds are available, with specific project costs to be approved as work is authorized, the proportionate cost of the airport development projects described above which are to be paid by the sponsor to the Secretary of the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (hereinafter referred to as the Secretary) to be held in trust for the purposes of the project; any unneeded and unspent balance after the project is completed is to be returned to the sponsor by the Secretary; the sponsor will make available any additional monies that may be found necessary, upon request of the Secretary, to complete the project as described above; the Secretary shall have the right to suspend or discontinue the project at any time additional monies are found to be necessary by the Secretary, and the sponsor does not provide the same; in the event the sponsor unilaterally terminates the project, all reasonable federal and state expenditures related to the project shall be paid by the sponsor; and

WHEREAS, the sponsor is required by Wis. Stat. §114.32(5) (1971) to designate the Secretary as its agent to accept,

receive, receipt for and disburse any funds granted by the United States under the Federal Airport and Airway Improvement Act, and is authorized by law to designate the Secretary as its agent for other purposes.

"DESIGNATION OF SECRETARY OF TRANSPORTATION AS SPONSOR'S AGENT"

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the sponsor that the Secretary is hereby designated as its agent and is requested to agree to act as such in matters relating to the airport development project described above, and is hereby authorized as its agent to make all arrangements for the development and final acceptance of the completed project whether by contract, agreement, force account or otherwise; and particularly, to accept, receive receipt for and disburse federal monies or other monies, either public or private, for the acquisition, construction, improvement, maintenance and operation of the airport; and, to acquire property or interests in property by purchase, gift, lease, or eminent domain under Wis. Stat. §32.02 (1995); and, to supervise the work of any engineer, appraiser, negotiator, contractor or other person employed by the Secretary; and, to execute any assurances or other documents required or requested by any agency of the federal government and to comply with all federal and state laws, rules, and regulations relating to airport development projects.

FURTHER, the sponsor requests that the Secretary provide, per Wis. Stat. §114.33(8)(a) (1971), that the sponsor may acquire the required land or interests in land that the Secretary shall find necessary to complete the aforesaid project.




