

RESOLUTION # 55-2023

Resolution to create a full time Economic Support Specialist.

Resolution approved for presentation to the Oneida County Board by the Supervisors of the Labor Relations Employee Services (LRES) Committee

Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Oneida County, Wisconsin:

WHEREAS, as a member of the Income Maintenance Central Consortium (Oneida, Marathon, Portage and Langlade counties) it has been determined that an additional Economic Support Specialist position be added at Oneida County due to workload requirements; and

WHEREAS, previously an Economic Support Specialist position was converted into a Lead Economic Support Specialist position, which does more training and less case management. At that time replacement of the Economic Support Specialist position was not warranted; and

WHEREAS, since the COVID Public Health Emergency, the consortia has seen a 40.72% increase in cases which will cause an increase in caseload management needs, including handling calls, processing renewals and support of other policies that were previously waved; and

WHEREAS, the consortium has received additional State and Federal funds to cover the costs of the position which will assist in the return to normal (pre-pandemic) workload requirements.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Oneida County Board of Supervisors, authorities and directs that a full-time Economic Support Specialist position be created in the Department of Social Services; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Oneida County Board of Supervisors that by adoption of this resolution it shall be deemed that all related costs, as set forth in the fiscal impact statement which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, shall be supported by non-tax levy funds. Should the funding decrease or increase the position shall be adjusted based on non-tax levy funds available.
