FOREST MANAGEMENT

- YTD Timber Stumpage Report Fiene reported stumpage for March was \$94,867.03 for YTD total of \$312,913.85. Things are pretty much shut down due to road limits.
- Timber Sale Extensions Fiene recommends 90-day extensions for sale #1724 Cloverland Logging, #1728 & #1731 Futurewood Corporation, and 1-year, 0% increase extensions for #1743 & #1744 Wayne Wagler Forest Products.
- Sorgel joined via Zoom at 3:38 p.m.
 - o Motion by Briggs to approve the timber sale extensions as recommended by Fiene. Second by Schultz. All aye, motion carried.
- Discuss/Approve Site Prep Bid Fiene explained the difficulty in getting bids for the pine plantation site prep project. After multiple attempts, the department received one bid from Future Forests, Inc. \$180 per acre which is within the budget of \$200 per acre.
