# BILLS, VOUCHERS AND LINE ITEM TRANSFERS FOR PUBLIC SAFETY DEPARTMENTS

MOTION: To approve the bills, vouchers, line item transfers and personal expense vouchers for Public Safety Departments (Fried/Timmons, PASSED).

### COURTHOUSE SECURITY/SINGLE POINT ENTRY

Fried indicated he would like to know where the Committee stands on a single point of entry at the courthouse. Fried indicated the Public Safety Committee would be the committee of jurisdiction for this matter. Discussion. Timmons expressed concern for handicapped persons and accessibility. Extensive discussion about the pros and cons of a single point of entry. Fried expressed concern for being prepared in the event of an emergency. It was suggested that this matter be put on the agenda for County Board to see if it would be supported.

MOTION: To give direction to Branch I and Branch II to inform the judges that the Public Safety Committee is supportive of approaching Administration on a single point

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of entry for the courthouse. An agenda item should be sent to the County Board to look for support before proceeding (Fried/Kelly, PASSED).

# **Emergency Management Director Retirement and Transition Plan**

Sheriff Grady Hartman indicated Emergency Management Director Ken Kortenhof will be retiring after 30 years of service. Sheriff Hartman indicated Kortenhof has given a generous notice and will be retiring in January 2022. Discussion. Sheriff Hartman indicated to the Committee that he would like to begin the search now for a replacement and have the replacement work with Kortenhof from October 2021 until Kortenhof's retirement for a smooth transition. Sheriff Hartman indicated he would like the Committee's permission to move forward with LRES and indicated there would be an overlap in salaries. Fried shared from October to Kortenhof's retirement is a long period of time. Sheriff Hartman indicated Kortenhof's position is wide ranging and multifaceted and a restructure of the position would not be feasible. Further discussion.

MOTION: To approve a new hire from October 1, 2021 through January 2022 to allow for transition of staff due to retirement of Emergency Management Director Ken Kortenhof. Approval for Sheriff Hartman to begin the process with LRES. (Timmons/Fried, PASSED).

It is anticipated a motion will be made, seconded and approved by roll call vote to enter into closed session pursuant to Section 19.85(1)(c) considering employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which this body has jurisdiction or responsibility.
