**BILLS, VOUCHERS AND LINE ITEM TRANSFERS FOR PUBLIC SAFETY DEPARTMENTS**

**MOTION:** To approve bills, vouchers, and line item transfers for Public Safety Departments (Fried/Kelly, PASSED).

Fried asked about the item listed as Sheriff's Reward and how that was funded and used. Captain Hook reported that an account was opened and funds were collected from the general public to assist with locating the suspect in a homicide case, besides monies that were budgeted. The total in the fund was \$13,800 and Hook reported \$10,000 came from the Emergency Contingency Fund (budgeted every year) and \$3,800 were donations from the public. Since there was assistance in locating the suspect, the reward was given. Fried asked who decided who gets the reward. Hook reported that per statute, the Sheriff does.

Fried noted that Branch I and Branch II were over budget already this year. Discussion was held regarding how dollars were taken out of the 2022 budget that need to go back into the 2022 budget and how that should be handled.




